SUMMARY:

Alberta S. Logan holds a substitute certificate of license to teach. Ms. Logan is not currently teaching in a Missouri public school.

On February 19, 2015, Ms. Logan pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence (SES) to the Misdemeanor, Theft/Stealing. The facts surrounding Ms. Logan's charge of theft/stealing involved Ms. Logan stealing money and merchandise from Anna's Linens. Ms. Logan was placed on two years of probation.

Ms. Logan received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented through counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:
