SUMMARY:

Applicant's Name: Noshella S. Lomax

On February 6, 2015, Ms. Lomax applied for a substitute certificate of license to teach.

Offense: On February 24, 1996, Ms. Lomax, age 19, and acting with another, appropriated seven (7) shirts, two (2) pair of shorts, and four (4) pair of pants with a value of at least one hundred and fifty dollars from Famous Barr, and when a law enforcement officer attempted to apprehend the defendants, Ms. Lomax attempted to cause physical injury by punching him in the face.

Disposition: On May 9, 1996, Ms. Lomax pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to the Felony, Stealing; and to the Misdemeanor, Assault On Law Enforcement Officer-3rd Degree, in the Circuit Court of St. Louis County, case number 2196R-01097A-01. Ms. Lomax was sentenced to three (3) years' supervised probation for Count I; and two (2) years' unsupervised probation for Count II. Probation was revoked on August 12, 1998 and extended until May 8, 2001.

Letters of Recommendation: Five (5) – (Associate, Executive Director, Friend, Program Director, Friend).
