Item**DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 4:**

The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education will improve departmental efficiency and operational effectiveness.

**SUMMARY:**

In January 2015, the State Board of Education approved a notice of proposed rulemaking to adopt 5 CSR 20-700.100, relating to the Statewide Longitudinal Data System. The notice of proposed rulemaking was published in the March 2, 2015 edition of the *Missouri Register* for comment. No comments were received during the 30-day comment period.

Pursuant to House Bill 1490, the proposed rule lists the data collected by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (Department) within the statewide longitudinal data system and defines the security process for maintaining the high quality student- and staff-level data.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education authorize publication of an order of rulemaking in the *Missouri Register* to adopt Rule 5 CSR 20-700.100, relating to the Statewide Longitudinal Data System and that the State Board finds this adoption necessary to carry out the purposes of Sections 161.092 and 161.096.

**ORDER OF RULEMAKING**

By the authority vested in the State Board of Education under sections 161.092 and 161.096, RSMo Supp. 2014, the board hereby adopts a rule as follows:

**5 CSR 20-700.100** Statewide Longitudinal Data System **is adopted.**

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed rule was published in the *Missouri Register* on March 2, 2015 (40 MoReg 227). No changes have been made to the text of the proposed rule, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed rule becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.
