# Certification Rules Update

## *School Leader K-12*

- Officially approved by State Board at its September meeting
- Must now complete rule-making process
- Amends requirements to align with the current Professional Standards for Educational Leaders (PSEL)
- Replaces Principal K-8, 5-9, 7-12
- Updates Field and Clinical Experiences
  - 3 semester hours, minimum of 300 clock hours
  - Includes a Major and Minor field experience

## *School Leader K-12*

- Establishes alignment with Missouri Leadership Development System (MLDS)
- Increases required years of teaching experience from 2 to 3 years
- Effective date is Fall 2020

## ***Career & Technical Education Administrator***

- Will meet same requirements as School Leader
- Adds new competencies specific to CTE programming, curriculum, funding, industry standards
- Will require a 3-semester hour (300 clock hour) clinical internship

## *Special Education Director K-12*

- Officially approved by State Board at its September meeting; must now complete rule-making process
- Amends requirements to align with the current Professional Standards for Educational Leaders (PSEL)

## ***Special Education Director K-12***

- Will meet same requirements as School Leader
- Will be an endorsement certificate; educator must first hold a School Leader or Principal certificate
- Will earn Special Ed Director certification by completing required micro credentials offered and approved by the DESE Office of Special Education

# *Temporary Authorization Certificate*

- Approved by State Board at its September meeting
- Must now complete rule-making process
- Aligns required coursework with current professional teacher standards
- Raises GPA requirement to meet current requirement
- Updates required assessments
- Updates renewal requirements
- Removes counselor certificate
- Effective date is August 2020

# Counselor Certificate

- Counselor K-12 certificate
  - ❑ Presented by school counselor organization to MACCE
  - ❑ Replaces K-8 and 7-12 certificate
  - ❑ Changes clinical experience requirement
    - 3-semester hours (300 clock hours); must complete hours at both the elementary and secondary level

# Counselor Certificate

- ❑ MACCE accepted the proposal at its September meeting
- ❑ Will be presented to State Board at its February meeting
- ❑ If approved, then it will begin the rule making process

# Clinical Experiences

- DESE Rule 5 CSR 20-400.330.
- This rule addresses the waiver of student teaching based upon teaching assistant experience.

# Clinical Experience


MACCE reviewed the rule and recommended the following update:  
Teacher Assistant Definition:

*An individual who is serving with teaching responsibilities comparable to a certificated teacher in a public school or accredited nonpublic school setting.*

Will be presented to State Board at its February meeting. If approved, it will then begin the rule making process.

# State Board Rulemaking Summary Process

(The Rulemaking Process takes approximately 7 months to complete.)



\*When the 90 day period for filing Order of Rulemaking ends with the SOS, if the rule hasn't been filed before this date, it lapses.

\*\*The State Plan exemption in Section 536.021, RSMo eliminates the final approval of the SBE of the Order of Rulemaking and several requirements in the ordinary rulemaking process





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
