1. Welcome – Robert Adams
 - a. Robert Adams welcomed members and guests. For the benefit of new members and guests, each member introduced himself/herself.
 - b. Robert Adams called for celebration items. Kay Coen celebrated Blue Springs High School marching band's performance in the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade. Nicole Nickens celebrated the Lee's Summit soccer team going to state and placing second. Nicole Nickens also celebrated her daughter graduating a semester early. Robert Adams celebrated his freezer being full, due to successful deer hunting.
2. New Members/Vacant Seats – Jacqueline McGill
 - a. Currently there are two vacant seats. Missouri Association of Colleges for Teacher Education (MACTE) and Missouri State Teachers Association (MSTA).
 - b. Kezia Bohanon has been recommended for appointment by MSTTA and her recommendation will go to the State Board of Education (SBE) in February.
3. Approval of Minutes – Jacqueline McGill
 - a. Jacqueline McGill called for the review of the September 9, 2019, minutes.
 - b. Jacqueline McGill called for a motion to approve the minutes. Cathy Pearman made the motion to approve the minutes. Allison O'very seconded the motion. Motion carried by a vote of 14 in favor; none opposed.
4. Certification Updates – Margery Tanner

 - a. The SBE at its September meeting officially approved the School Leader K-12 certificate. The certificate must now complete the rule-making process. The changes will become effective fall 2020.
 - b. The Career & Technical Education Administrator certificate will meet the same requirements as the School Leader certificate. In addition, new competencies specific to career technical education will be included along with a 3-semester hour (300-clock hour) clinical internship.

- c. The SBE at its September meeting officially approved the Special Education Director K-12 certificate. The Special Education Director K-12 must now complete the rule-making process. The changes will become effective fall 2020.
 - d. The SBE at its September meeting officially approved recommended changes to the Temporary Authorization Certificate. The Temporary Authorization Certificate must now complete the rule-making process. The changes will become effective fall 2020.
 - e. At its September meeting, MACCE accepted the proposed changes to the Counselor certificate. The proposed changes replace the K-8 and 7-12 certificate with a Counselor K-12 certificate; a 3-semester hour clinical internship must be completed which includes hours at both the elementary and secondary levels. The proposed changes will be presented to the SBE at its February meeting.
 - f. MACCE reviewed the Clinical Experience rule and recommended an update to the teacher assistant definition. The recommended change will be presented to the SBE at its February meeting.
5. Library Media Specialist K-12 - Amy Taylor
- a. Amy Taylor with the Missouri Association of School Librarians (MASL) proposed changes to adding a Library Media Specialist certificate by passing the designated assessment. To add library media specialist to a certification by passing the assessment MASL proposed that an applicant must also complete the following core content knowledge courses:
 - i. Foundations of Librarianship
 - ii. Library Media Administration
 - iii. Developing and Managing Collections
 - iv. Organizing Information
 - b. Discussion was held.
 - c. Paula York made the motion to accept the proposal as written. Allison O'very seconded the motion.
 - d. Discussion was held.
 - e. Kathy Steinhoff made a friendly amendment to the motion to change the four core content knowledge courses to a minimum of three courses and that the list of coursework be flexible.
 - f. Paula York accepted the friendly amendment. Kay Coen seconded the motion with the amendment. Motion failed by a vote of four in favor; eight opposed.
 - g. Discussion was held.
 - h. Nicole Nickens made the motion to accept the proposal as presented from MASL. Kay Coen seconded the motion. Motion carried by a vote of nine in favor and five opposed.
6. Special Reading K-12 Certificate - Kim Stuckey
- a. Kim Stuckey presented information on reading instruction and reading teachers.
 - b. Margery Tanner requested that MACCE consider creating an ad hoc committee to review and possibly revise the requirements for the Special Reading K-12 certificate.
 - c. Margery Tanner requested that names for the committee be submitted at February meeting. Cathy Pearman volunteered to lead the committee.
