# ABCTE

## **American Board for Certification of Teacher Excellence (ABCTE)**

- ABCTE is a national organization which offers teacher certification.
- This route to certification was approved by the Missouri legislature in 2003.
- An ABCTE certificate is currently accepted by 11 states.

Upon issuance of the ABCTE certificate, an individual may apply for a Missouri initial professional teaching certificate.

- MACCE recommended discontinuing the issuance of Unified Science certificates.
- Presented to State Board at its December meeting.
- Public comment ends April 1, 2019.

# Substitute Certificate

60 semester  
hours

Accredited IHE

Valid for 4 years



- Rule changes were presented to State Board of Education at its March meeting.
- Clarifies language, including that acceptable semester hours must be completed through a regionally accredited institution
- Must complete 1 hour of professional development annually to renew
- Rule-making process takes approximately 7-9 months

## Computer Science K-12 Certificate

- Add-on certificate only
- Available beginning 7/1/2019
- Will be added by passing computer science content assessment
- Educator Preparation and Pearson are developing an assessment based on computer science standards recommended by Office of Quality Schools

# Literacy Requirements

- New Literacy requirements approved by State Board
- Become effective August 1, 2019
- Educator Preparation Programs are currently updating their programs
- Areas of Certification:
  - Elementary Education
  - Early Childhood Education
  - Early Childhood Special Education
  - Mild/Moderate Cross Categorical Special Education

# Principal Certificate

## *Proposed Rule Changes:*

- New Name: School Leader K-12
- Amend requirements to align with the current Professional Standards for Educational Leaders (PSEL).
- Replace Principal K-8, 5-9, & 7-12
- Update Field and Clinical Experiences
  - 3 semester hours, minimum of 300 clock hours
  - Includes a Major and Minor field experience

## Career Ed Director

- Amend requirements to align with the current Professional Standards for Educational Leaders (PSEL).
- Review proposed coursework requirements specific to CTE leadership.

# Special Ed Director K-12

- Amend requirements to align with the current Professional Standards for Educational Leaders (PSEL).
- Review proposed requirements specific to Special Education leadership

# Transition Administrator Certificate

## *Proposed Rule Changes*

- Complete a minimum of 8 semester hours towards an EdS or EdD in educational administration

**OR**

- *Demonstrated mastery of Leadership Development System Competencies at the **Emerging** Level 5 micro-credentials*

# Career Administrator Certificate

## *Proposed Rule Change:*

- Earned EdS or EdD in educational administration

**OR**

- *Demonstrated mastery of Leadership Development System Competencies at the **Developing** Level 5 micro-credentials*



# Temporary Authorization Certificate

# Temporary Authorization Certificate (TAC)

One-year, renewable, certificate

*Eligibility Criteria:*

- Bachelor's Degree in a Content Area
- Minimum GPA of 2.75 Overall and 3.00 in Content Area
- Employment with a Missouri School District
- Offered for areas of middle school, secondary, or special education



# TAC Requirements

- DESE-specified professional education coursework (minimum of 24 semester hours)
- Pass 2 assessments: one in content area & one in pedagogy
- 2 years of mentoring
- 2 years of teaching experience
