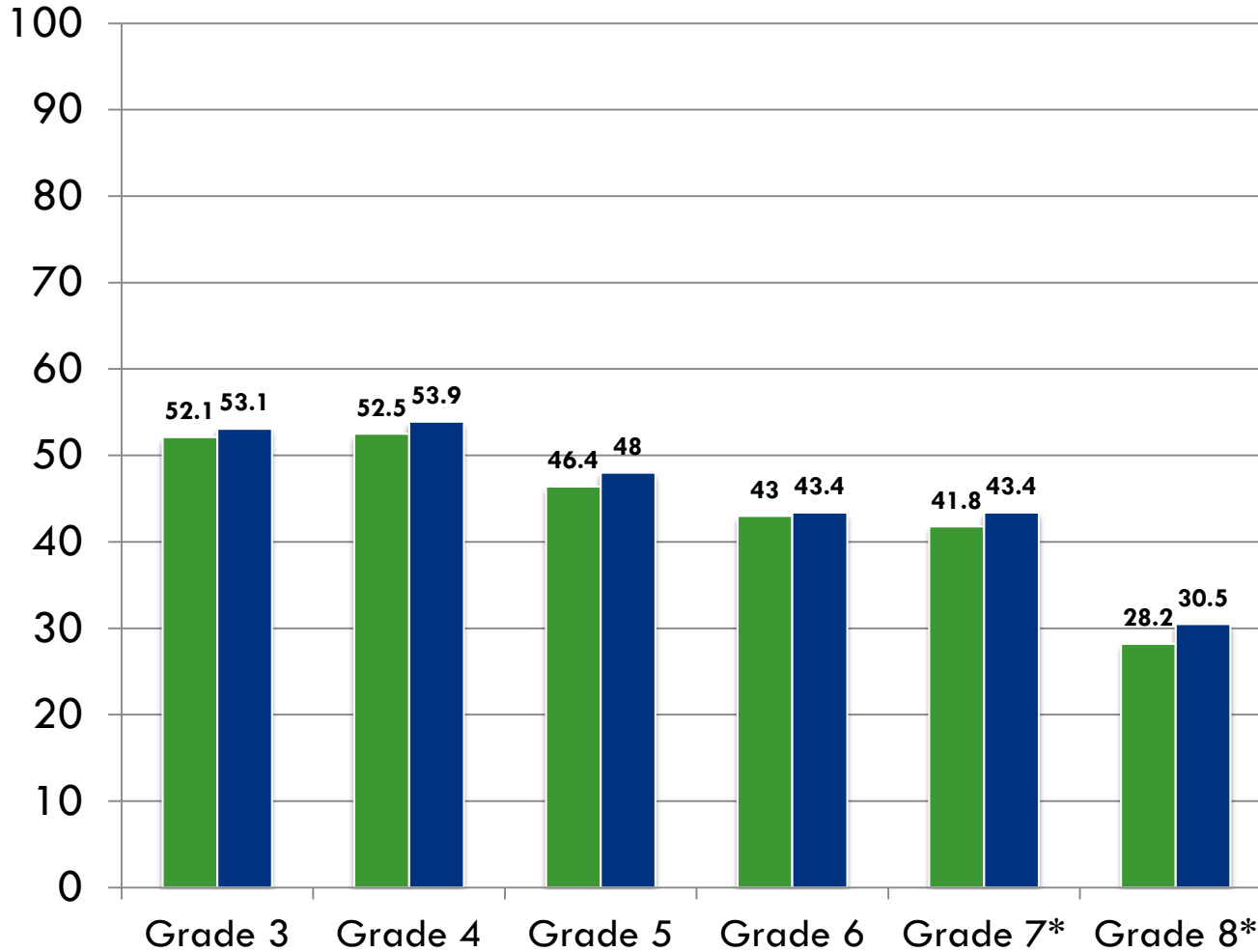

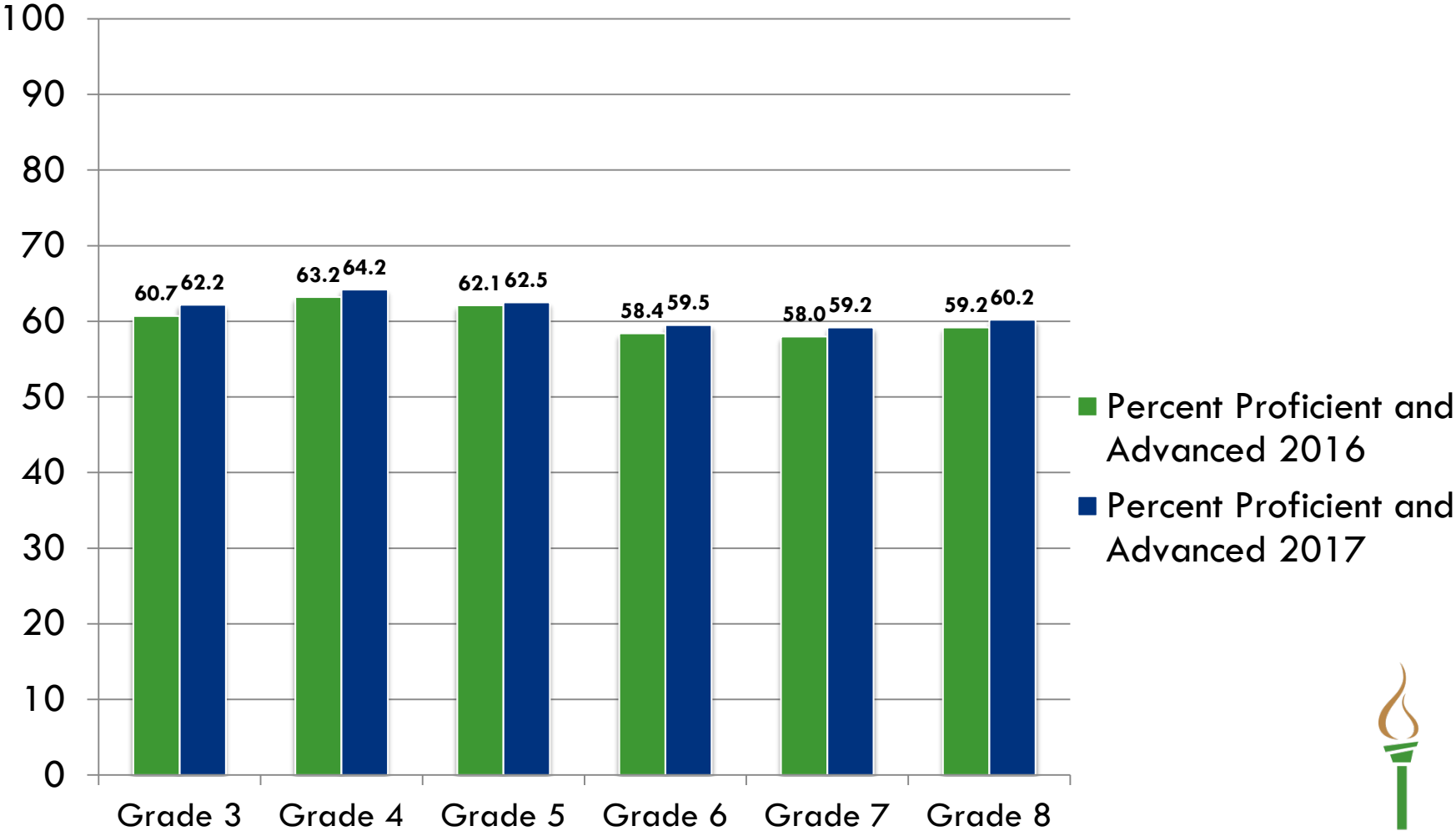
■ Percent Proficient and Advanced 2016

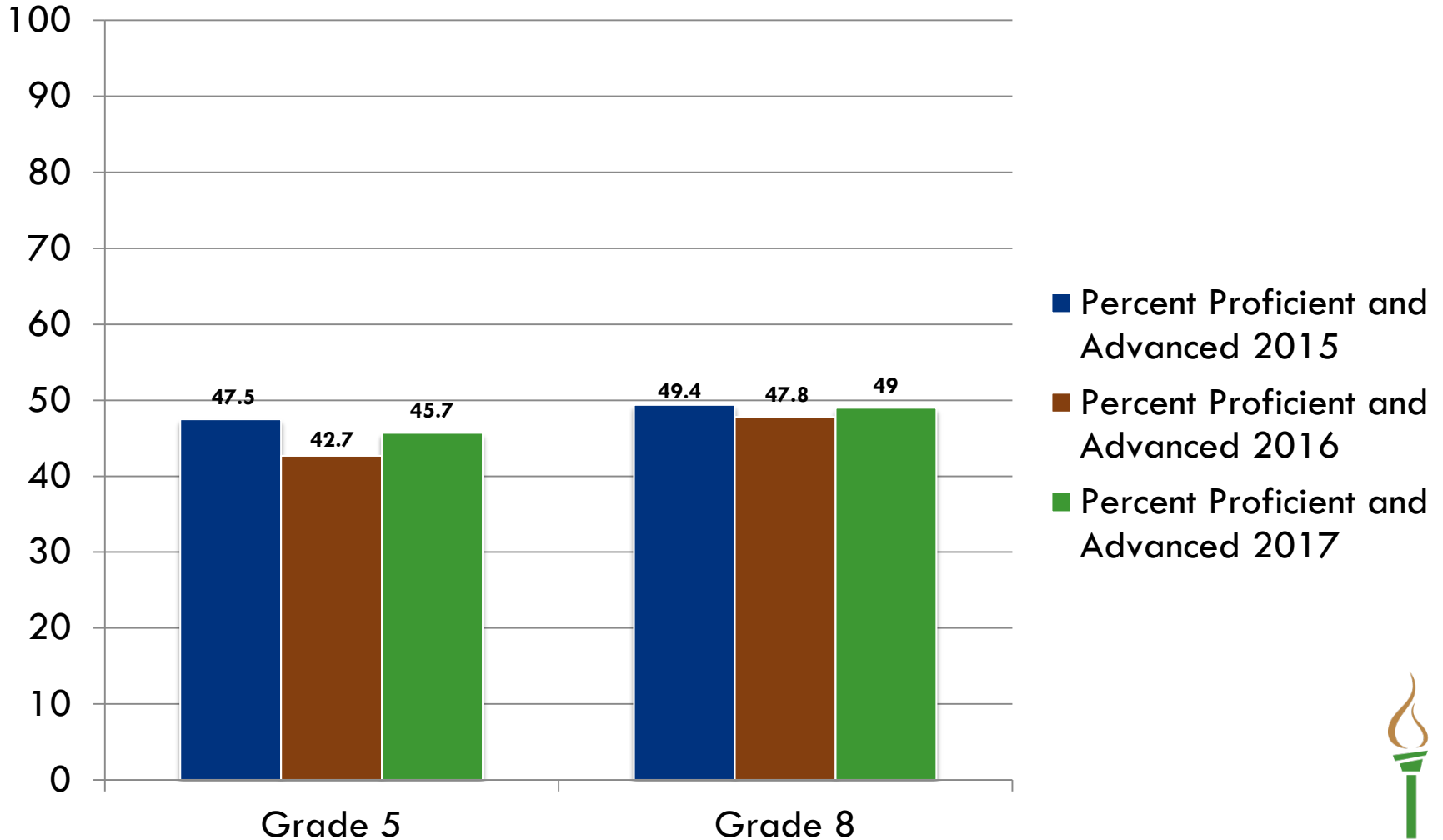


Grade-Level English Language Arts Proficient and Advanced



Grade-Level Science Proficient and Advanced

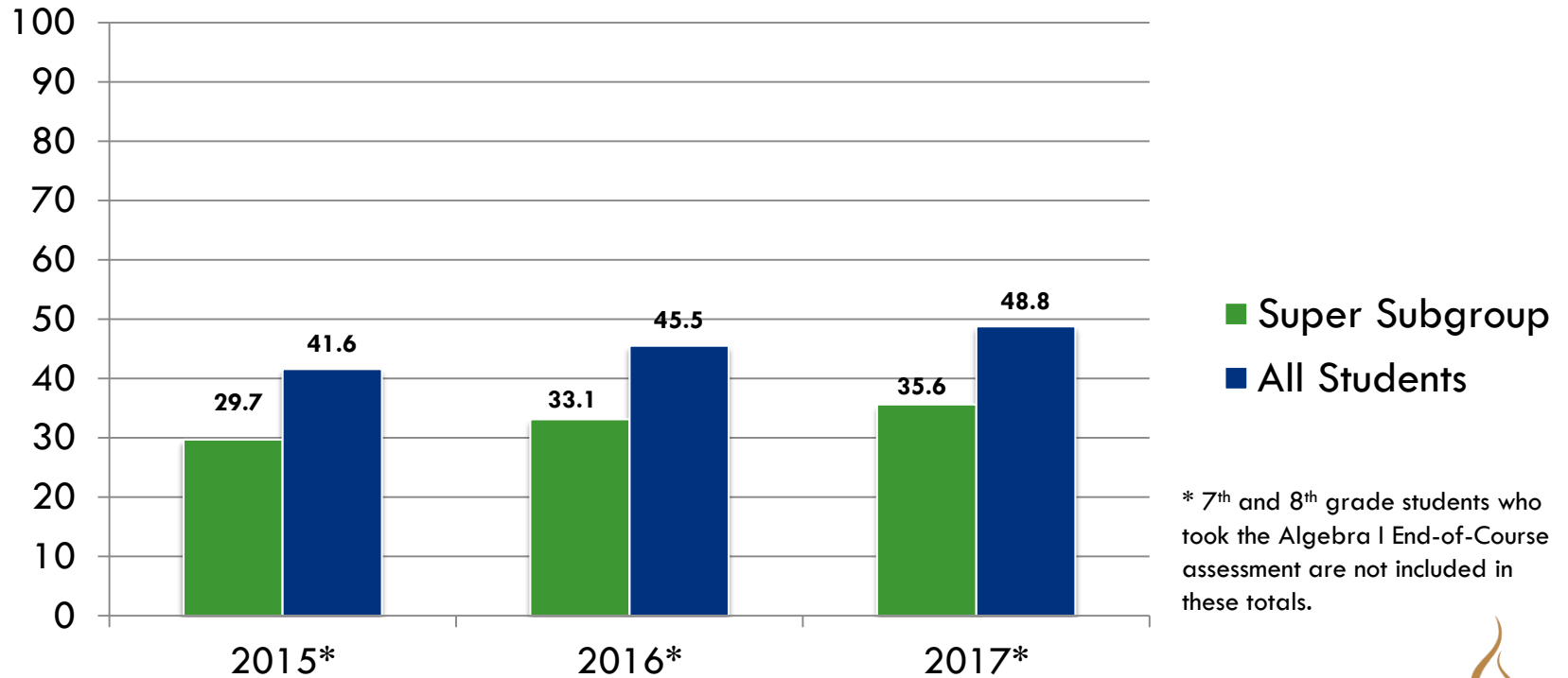

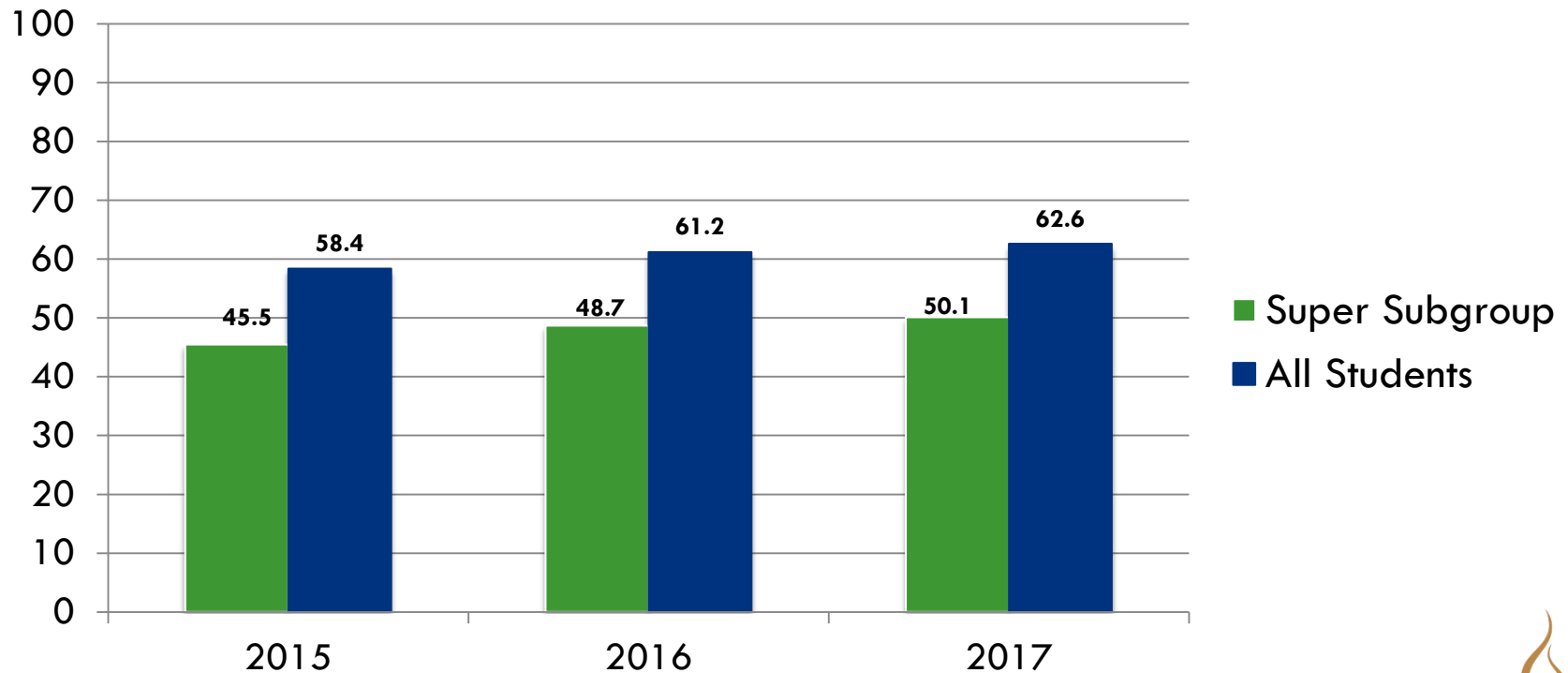
