Missouri Career Education is preparing young people and adults for the job market and/or further education. Missouri career education combines academics and job-specific skill training to assist in narrowing the skills gap in Missouri.

CTE programs are offered in

- Health Sciences

- Marketing
- Skilled Technical Sciences
- Technology and Engineering

Missouri's delivery system consists of

- 57 area career centers
- 444 comprehensive high schools
- State Technical College of Missouri
- 12 community college districts
- Seven four-year institutions
- Two state agencies - Department of Corrections and Department of Social Services



Statistics

- *64% of all high school students in Missouri took at least one career education course or program.*
- *8,165 high school students received an industry-recognized certificate or credential.*
- *A recent follow-up of 2015 secondary graduates of career education programs show that 95.1 percent are employed, continuing education, or serving in the military, and 67.4 percent are in the area related to their career education program of study.*
- *For postsecondary graduates, 68.6 percent are employed, continuing education, or serving in the military, and 54.6 percent are in the area related to their career education program of study.*


