

2009 CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION PERKINS PERFORMANCE REPORTS ARE NOW AVAILABLE.

The reports are provided in three separate categories.

1. Secondary
2. Adult
3. Postsecondary

Currently there are 88 secondary fiscal agents serving secondary student grades 9-12, four adult fiscal agents serving students beyond high school that do not earn college credit. And 14 postsecondary fiscal agents that serve students beyond high school that earn college credits.

The performance levels are negotiated with the US Department of Education Office of Vocational and Adult Education.

Missouri will be held accountable for meeting at least 90% of each agreed-upon performance level or be required to implement a program improvement plan pursuant to section 123(a)(1) of Perkins IV.

To access the reports

Go to DESE's homepage

- Click on DESE Web Applications
- Click on Public Applications
- Click on ePeGS (under Cross-Divisional Systems)
- Click on the "Select" button (you do not have to select a school district at this point)
- Click on Report Menu (left side)
- Select which set of reports you want to view
 - o Click on "Show" beside Perkins IV Reports – Secondary
 - o Click on "Show" beside Perkins IV Reports – Postsecondary
 - o Click on "Show" beside Perkins IV Reports – Adult
- Select which report you want to view by report level
 - For example:
 - o To view Consortium data
 - Click Postsecondary Participation – Consortium Level
 - o To view District data
 - Click Postsecondary Participation – District Level

- To view Statewide data
 - Click Postsecondary Participation – State Level
- Select the year
 - For Postsecondary & Adult, there is only data available in the 2008-2009 year
 - For Secondary, there is data available for 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 years.
- Click on dropdown arrow and select District or Consortium, by county district code, you want to view
- Click “Get Report”

When the new window opens, you can select the report you would like to view. Remember to change the year to 2008-2009 and select the district you are wanting to see, click Get Report.

This data is being collected daily but it is an overnight process, so if schools correct the data today it will not be viewable until tomorrow.
