**DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:**

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

**SUMMARY:**

Kelly W. Martin holds a lifetime certificate of license to teach in the areas of Coaching, grades 7-12, and Speech/Theatre, grades 7-12. Mr. Martin also held an administrator certificate of license to teach for Principal, grades 9-12, that expired on September 22, 2004 and a professional certificate of license to teach in the area of Physical Education, grades 7-12, that expired on October 2, 2007. Mr. Martin is not currently teaching in Missouri.

On April 17, 2006, Mr. Martin pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to the Felony, Driving While Intoxicated–Persistent Offender. Mr. Martin received five (5) years’ supervised probation. On March 23, 2010, Mr. Martin’s probation was revoked, and he was placed on a new five (5) year term of supervised probation scheduled to end on March 23, 2015. Mr. Martin’s probation order was amended when the court learned that Mr. Martin was in in-patient treatment, which prevented his appearance at a scheduled court date. On December 27, 2013, Mr. Martin was discharged from probation.

Mr. Martin was present at the hearing, but was not represented by counsel.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the State Board of Education take no action against Mr. Martin’s teaching certificate.
