SUMMARY:

Victoria A. Marut holds a content substitute certificate of license to teach. Her certification is current and active. Ms. Marut is not currently teaching in Missouri.

On June 3, 2013, Ms. Marut pled guilty and received a suspended imposition of sentence to the Felony, Forgery. Ms. Marut received five (5) years' supervised probation.

Ms. Marut received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.
