SUMMARY:

Judith A. Masse holds a career continuous professional certificate of license to teach in the area of Mild/Moderate Behavior Disorder, grades K–12, and an expired adult literacy certificate.

Educator Certification's staff assignment report regarding Ms. Masse indicates that she was last employed by a Missouri public school district in the 2002–2003 school year.

On October 31, 2013, Ms. Masse pled guilty and received a suspended imposition of sentence to the Felony, Resisting Arrest. Ms. Masse received five (5) years' supervised probation.

Ms. Masse received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the State Board of Education revoke Ms. Masse's teaching certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2014).
