Geometry	High School	The standard G.MG.3 reads, "Apply geometric methods to solve design problems (e.g. desiging an object or structure to satisfy physical constraints or minimize cost; working with typographic grid systems based on ratios.) In the released EOC for Geometry this standard was cited in three questions that all dealt with Vertex-Edge Graphs also called Networks. This standard does not lead a teacher to believe they should teach Vertex-Edge Graphs. In fact I do not see anywhere the Geometry standards address this topic. In other state standards Vertex-Edge Graphs are assigned a separate standard that clearly specifies Vertex-Edge Graphs and related topics. This standard is not clear and helpful to MO teachers. When I researched typographic grid systems I could not find any information connecting Vertex-Edge Graphs to typographic grid systems except in other states standards.	Yes	Educator	64080
