DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

SUMMARY:

Frederick L. Mathis holds a lifetime certificate of license to teach in the areas of Elementary Education, grades 1-8, and Social Studies, grades 7-9. His certification is current and active. Mr. Mathis is not currently teaching in Missouri.

On December 21, 2012, Mr. Mathis pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to the Felony, Domestic Assault-2nd Degree. Mr. Mathis was placed on five (5) years' supervised probation.

Mr. Mathis received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the State Board of Education revoke Mr. Mathis' teaching certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2014).
