SUMMARY:

Nancy K. McClelland, Respondent, holds a lifetime certificate of license to teach in elementary education, grades K-8. Her certification is current and active.

In March 2005, Respondent pled guilty and was convicted of three (3) separate drug-related felonies by possessing the chemicals and tools with the intent to produce methamphetamine, and by possessing methamphetamine with the intent to use.

Respondent received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:
