**DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:**

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

**SUMMARY:**

Daniel P. McSparin holds an active substitute teaching certificate. Mr. McSparin is not currently teaching in a Missouri public school.

On November 30, 2015, Mr. McSparin pled guilty to two counts of the Misdemeanor, Attempted Age Misrepresentation With Intent to Solicit a Minor (via the Internet) for Sexual Misconduct and to the Felony, Attempted Statutory Sodomy – 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree. Mr. McSparin was sentenced to serve 90 days in jail on the two counts of Misdemeanor, Attempted Age Misrepresentation With Intent to Solicit a Minor (via the Internet) for Sexual Misconduct to be served concurrent with his sentence of four years of incarceration in the Missouri Department of Corrections on the Felony, Attempted Statutory Sodomy – 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree.

Mr. McSparin was neither present at the hearing nor was he represented through counsel.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education revoke Mr. McSparin’s certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (2016).
