**SUMMARY**

On December 16, 2019, Ms. Mellington applied for a Missouri substitute certificate of license to teach.

On June 27, 2006, Kindra Leanne Mellington, age 22, was charged with Felony, DWI. On May 2, 2007, Ms. Mellington pled guilty to Felony DWI and received a suspended execution of sentence (SES) with five years of supervised probation. On June 24, 2012, Ms. Mellington was released from probation after completing all requirements of her sentence.


