SUMMARY:

Sabrina L. Meredith, Respondent, holds a Career Continuous Professional Certificate in Elementary Education for grades 1–6.

In June 2013, Respondent pleaded guilty to one (1) count of Felony Stealing and was sentenced to 60 days in the St. Charles County jail with a suspended imposition of sentence and five (5) years supervised probation.

Respondent received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.
