DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

SUMMARY:

Craig R. Meyer holds a lifetime certificate in Social Studies, grades 7–12. His certification is current and active. Mr. Meyer is not currently teaching in Missouri.

On July 5, 2005, Mr. Meyer pled guilty to the Felony, Distributing Controlled Substance Near Schools. Mr. Meyer was sentenced to eight (8) years’ of incarceration. After 120 days, Respondent was released and placed on five (5) years’ probation.

On June 3, 2004, Mr. Meyer pled guilty to the Misdemeanor, Driving While Intoxicated. Mr. Meyer was fined \$500 plus court costs.

Mr. Meyer received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the State Board of Education revoke Mr. Meyer’s teaching certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2014).
