DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

SUMMARY:

The Missouri Performance Assessments are part of the Missouri Educator Gateway Assessments (MEGA). They provide a measure of a candidates' ability to put into practice what they have learned during the educator preparation process.

The first performance assessment of this battery to be developed, piloted and implemented in the state of Missouri is the Missouri School Leaders Performance Assessment (MoSLPA). Industry standards defined the processes used to develop the Missouri Performance Assessments. A fifteen member team comprised of PK-12 leaders and leadership preparation faculty contributed in the development of the assessment. The MoSLPA was piloted in the spring 2014 and implemented in fall 2014.

The Department's recommendation for setting the initial Missouri Qualifying Score for the MoSLPA assessment is based upon the results from a Standard Setting Panel and the recommendations of the Missouri Advisory Council for the Certification of Educators (MACCE) and the Missouri Advisory Committee for Educator Preparation (MABEP). The Missouri Qualifying Score will be in effect for candidates enrolled in leadership preparation programs beginning this fall.

PRESENTERS:

Paul Katnik, Assistant Commissioner; and Gale "Hap" Hairston, Director, Educator Preparation, Office of Educator Quality will assist in the presentation and discussion of this agenda item.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education approve the Missouri Qualifying Score of 41 for the Missouri School Leaders Performance Assessment beginning on August 31, 2015. The Office of Educator Quality will closely monitor the results of the MoSLPA during the 2015-2016 academic year.
