- Candidate identifiers
- Placement school (district code, school code)
- Ratings from:
 - Cooperating Teacher
 - Program Supervisor
 - Building Principal



MEEES Validation Study

- REL Central leading the study
- Research Questions
 - Determine scales and/or subscales—does the MEEES form measure multiple distinct aspects of professional practice?
 - Inter-rater reliability – how consistent are the three raters?
 - Do the MEEES forms seem to measure the same things the same ways in different contexts (different placements, different kinds of candidates, etc.)
 - How do MEEES scores relate to Tripod and MEP?
 - To what extent does the MEEES differentiate candidates?

Ed Prep Annual Participation

- **New MOSIS Collection**
- **Also known as “Pipeline” collection**
- **Purpose**
 - **Shortage Predictor Model**
 - **Recruitment and Retention**
- **Annual Program Census**
 - **All formal admits to EPP**
 - **Includes counselors, librarians, and leadership programs**



Pipeline Definitions

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- **Admitted**
 - Defined by the EPP
 - Must minimally include passing the entry assessment (CBASE/MoGEA), where applicable
- **Participating**
 - Previously admitted, but not yet a completer
 - Parallel to Title II “Other Enrolled” or “Other Enrolled, All but Clinical”
- **Other**
 - Completer, dropout, or transferred to another institution
 - All records must eventually have this status

Community College APR

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- **Sub-Committee Members**
 - One per Community College
 - Please nominate two representative from a four-year public and two representative from a four-year private independent program
- **Possible Indicators**
 - CBASE / MoGEA
 - GPA
 - Four-Year Completion

Community College Impact

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- **Total of 392 four-year completers in 2014 held an AAT**
- **Over nine percent had an AAT**
- **AATs most frequently granted by:**
 - **Ozarks Technical Community College**
 - **St. Louis Community College**
 - **Metropolitan Community College**
 - **Mineral Area College**
 - **Jefferson College**
