



Summer School

Summer school registration for the Missouri Virtual Instruction Program (MoVIP) is underway! The first set of classes begins May 11, and students must register at least one week prior to the start of class.

MoVIP offers virtual online courses for students statewide. Students can take an entire course from any Internet-connected computer, available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. MoVIP is a K-12 program.

Summer classes through MoVIP offer students the opportunity to hold a summer job and still take classes. Smaller school districts are able to offer more courses with MoVIP, and, in certain circumstances, local districts may agree to pay students' tuition.

There are several nine-week sessions available:

- 6/1/16 – 8/5/16
- 6/8/16 – 8/12/16
- 6/15/16 – 8/19/16
