SUMMARY:

In 2014, the State Board of Education (State Board) determined the only feasible way to maintain schools in the Normandy School District was to lapse the district and provide direct oversight by the State Board of Education. The State Board authorized the establishment of the Normandy Schools Collaborative (NSC) to be governed by a Joint Executive Governing Board (JEGB).


