Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

SUMMARY:

In October 2013 the Council of Chief State School Officers (CCSSO) launched the Network for Transforming Educator Preparation (NTEP) to support states in their work to implement the policy recommendations put forth in the 2012 Task Force Report *Our Responsibility, Our Promise*. The accomplishments of the initial cohort of states in reforming educator preparation over the past two years demonstrates the power of collaborative efforts among state agencies, PreK-12 educators and those working in educator preparation programs. Changing the way we prepare future teachers and leaders is best supported and sustained where there is collaborative stakeholder engagement that includes opportunity to participate in a network with colleagues from other forward thinking states.

CCSSO has launched the next phase of this network. Missouri and other select states have been invited to join NTEP for two (2) years beginning October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2017. Missouri's invitation to participate in this work was based on evidence of the efforts underway and a collective dedication to ensuring teachers and principals entering the profession are ready day one. As a member of NTEP, Missouri will have opportunities to continue its work with state education agencies, higher education leaders and dozens of national organizations and thought partners while learning from efforts underway in others states.

This presentation will provide an overview of Missouri's progress in NTEP and a review of possible goals over the next two (2) years.
