I. Get to MAP-A Page

1. Go to dese.mo.gov
2. In the topics box in the middle of the page click on MAP
3. In the College & Career Readiness Box on the right click on MAP-A
4. Scroll Down to Find:
 - Test Dates
 - Tabs for: Administration, Eligibility, Manuals, Resources, Training, Home Learning

Important Things in the Tabs

Administrative Resources: Best Practices Timelines, Instructionally Embedded Process. Performance Level Descriptors

Eligibility: MAP-A checklist, Flow Chart and Guidance Document, Crosswalks, Instruction and Assessment Planner Hand-Out

2. In the topics box in the middle of the page click on learning standards
3. In the middle of the page under Missouri Learning Standards click on Alternative
4. In the Assessed Standards you will find the Essential Elements
5. In the Additional Resources you will find the MAP Alternative Crosswalk for ELA, Math & Science
