DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 1:

All Missouri students will graduate college and career ready.

SUMMARY:

The State Board of Education authorized the establishment of the Normandy Schools Collaborative, to be governed by a Joint Executive Governing Board, to provide leadership to the new local education agency, pursuant to Missouri law, Section 162.081, RSMo.

On June 16, 2014, the State Board of Education created and established the Joint Executive Governing Board and appointed its board members.

On January 22, 2015, Dr. Charles Pearson, of St. Louis, Missouri, resigned as a board member of the Joint Executive Governing Board and was hired as the interim superintendent of the Normandy Schools Collaborative.

A candidate, who will replace Dr. Pearson and fulfill the remainder of Dr. Pearson’s term as a board member of the Joint Executive Governing Board, will be presented for consideration by the State Board of Education.

The candidate would serve on the Joint Executive Governing Board until June 30, 2017, unless extended by the State Board of Education prior to that date, or until the Joint Executive Governing Board is dissolved by action of the State Board of Education.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education appoint the designated individual to serve on the Joint Executive Governing Board for the Normandy Schools Collaborative effective June 16, 2015 through June 30, 2017, as presented.
