SUMMARY:

Applicant's Name: William G. Nobles, Sr.

On August 5, 2014, William G. Nobles, Sr. applied for a Missouri temporary certificate of license to teach in the area of Auto Mechanic, grades S-P.

Offense: On January 17, 2009, William Nobles, Sr. age 42, attempted to cause physical injury to the victim, a family or household member, by punching her in the face.

Disposition: On November 16, 2010, William Nobles, Sr. pled guilty and received a suspended imposition of sentence to the misdemeanor, Domestic Assault - 3rd Degree - 1st/2nd Offense, in the Circuit Court of St. Francois County, case number 09D7-CR00440. Mr. Nobles received two years' supervised probation, which was successfully completed.
