DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

SUMMARY:

Jay K. Oetman holds a substitute certificate of license to teach. His certification is current and active. Mr. Oetman is not currently teaching in Missouri.

On June 4, 2014, Mr. Oetman pled guilty and received a suspended imposition of sentence to one (1) count of the Felony, Possession of a Controlled Substance; one (1) count of the Misdemeanor, Possession of Marijuana, and one (1) count of the Misdemeanor, Unlawful use of Drug Paraphernalia. Mr. Oetman received five (5) years' supervised probation for the felony count and two (2) years' probation for the misdemeanor counts.

Mr. Oetman received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the State Board of Education revoke Mr. Oetman's teaching certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2014).
