

Paragraph 2:

Some school districts provide transportation for children to obtain medically necessary services provided as a result of a child's Individual Education Plan (IEP). Transportation to these services for Medicaid eligible students is referred to as Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT). Districts may claim reimbursement for transportation to and from school for Medicaid eligible students on the days that IEP therapy services are provided.
