Item**DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 1:**

All Missouri students will graduate college and career ready.

SUMMARY:

In 2006, the State Board of Education revised graduation requirements for Missouri students to include one-half credit of personal finance. The personal finance learning standards have not been reviewed over the last ten years. The financial landscape in Missouri, the United States, and the world has changed drastically since 2006. A review of the current personal finance learning standards is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education convene a work group to review personal finance learning standards, including notification to the other nominating entities as specified in Sections 160.514 RSMo.
