**SUMMARY:**

Applicant's Name: Kimberly A. Peters

On November 18, 2014, Ms. Peters applied for a substitute certificate of license to teach.

Offense: 1. On April 25, 2004, Ms. Peters, age 35, acted with criminal negligence by operating a vehicle in which two (2) minor children were passengers, while intoxicated and failing to maintain control of the vehicle, causing it to veer from its proper lane of travel and becoming involved in an accident.

2. On September 11, 2005, Ms. Peters, age 37, operated a vehicle while intoxicated and drove the wrong way on a one way street.

Disposition: 1. April 20, 2005, Ms. Peters pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to two (2) counts of the Misdemeanor, Endangering the Welfare of a Child; and to one (1) count of the Misdemeanor, DWI, in the Circuit Court of Greene County, case number 31304CF7357. Ms. Peters was sentenced to two (2) years' supervised probation, which was completed on April 18, 2007.

2. On March 23, 2006, Ms. Peters pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to the Misdemeanor, DWI, in the Circuit Court of Greene County, case number 31305CM11473. Ms. Peters was sentenced to two (2) years' unsupervised probation, which was completed on March 22, 2008.

Letters of Recommendation: Four (4) – (Retired Educator, Friend, Friend, Daughter).
