Portell applied for a reactivation of a Missouri certificate of license to teach. He currently holds an expired PC I certificate of license to teach in the area of Physical Education, grades K-12.</p> <p><u>Disposition:</u></p> <p>On November 13, 2001, Mr. Portell pled guilty and received a suspended imposition of sentence (SIS).</p> <p>On June 5, 2005, Mr. Portell, age 28, pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence (SES) to Felony, DWI-Alcohol-Persistent Offender in the Circuit Court of Jefferson County, Missouri, case number 23CR304-2519. He was ordered to serve five years supervised probation.
