

What does student success look like to you?

- ① Group of well adjusted students know how to learn + how to discover on their own.
- ② ~~What~~ We are training them to use their learning when they leave K-12
- ③ What can they do with their learning now? Are they contributing to their school comm.
- ④ Does the learning apply to outside of school
- ⑤ At what point to we judge success? ⑥ #1 concern - work ethic!!
- ⑦ Have we lost the sense of responsibility? ⑧ Are teachers facilitating learning + do students own their learning? ⑨ How much time should we spend on essential skills? or should we be pushing forward toward the goal? ⑩ Students cannot be successful until they are ready to learn when they get to school! - must have supportive / nourishing school readiness.

What do school communities need to do to prepare students for success after graduation?

- ① Growing movement to remove the stigma of having to go to college! We have a shortage of skilled craftsmen!! We need these to make a successful community! ② Expose students early + often to the wide array of "jobs" out there!! ③ We must provide a better support system!
- ④ Must address student needs - health, nutrition, mental health + provide avenues for access to these services. ⑤ Develops career + technical centers to help students be ready to achieve. ⑥ Helps students to be ready for the 21st century jobs + the changes they will see in 5 - or 10 years! ⑦ Help students "learn to fail" - life isn't all A grades!! ⑧ Give teachers the tools + education to allow them to succeed + then their students can succeed!!

How will you know Missouri schools have been effective in preparing students for success after graduation?

- ① Ask the employers!! ② We have failed to teach students to think critically! They must learn to formulate thought and be able to share their thoughts with others. ③ When we see less remediation in college then we will know that K-12 succeeded!! ④ Our system is so based on accountability + a pz! We must work past this teaching to the test.
- ⑤ If schools were accountable for a critical thinking metric then they would have created it + worked toward this goal. ⑥ Do we underestimate the value of extra curricular activities and learning. (soft skills - how to work with others) ⑦ it's hard to measure "soft skills."
- ⑧ Do we assess competencies? ~~not that~~ When the student learns a skill or lesson we mark this as achieved. ⑨ Is there a disconnect between what schools teach children they need + what they should truly learn to do?
