Equity of access to quality – coherent curriculum, quality teachers (reflective, caring, competent), availability of resources. Fidelity of implementation of best practices, (formative assessment, collaboration, student goal setting →

What do school communities need to do to prepare students for success after graduation?

① *Systems + resources to help students be successful (stay away from punitive measures) specifically around mental health + behavior needs -*

both inside the school (full-time school psychologists, counselors, + mental health supports)

+ within the community (pool resources), foster care, justice, community mental health)

② *High quality vocational + life skills programs - not only being evaluated by # of students who go to college - consider trades*

How will you know Missouri schools have been effective in preparing students for success after graduation?

Students make adequate growth along the way

Kids feel physically + emotionally safe at school

① *Measure the culture + climate of the school + make it mandatory so we can assess safety, relationships*

② *Fewer kids are incarcerated, lower dropout rates, Post-grad survey success in college/vocational/trade/military -> 10 yr. employment rates*

③ *Families stay in the community due to a healthy school district*
