**STRATEGIC PRIORITY**

Teachers and Leaders – Prepare, develop and support educators to ensure an effective teacher in every classroom and an effective leader in every school.

**SUMMARY**

On December 6, 2018, the State Board of Education approved a notice of proposed rulemaking to rescind Rule 5 CSR 20-400.280. This rule is being rescinded due to current requirements being contained within Rule 5 CSR 20-400.510 – 20-400.680 thus making 5 CSR 20-400.280 redundant.

**RECOMMENDATION**

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education authorize publication in the *Missouri Register* of an order of rulemaking to rescind Rule 5 CSR 20-400.280, Required Assessments for Professional Education Certification in Missouri, and that the State Board finds the proposed rescission necessary to carry out the purposes of Sections 161.092, 168.011, 168.021, 168.071, 168.081, 168.400, 168.405, and 168.409, RSMo.

**ORDER OF RULEMAKING**

By the authority vested in the State Board of Education under sections 161.092, 168.021, 168.071, 168.081, and 168.400, RSMo Supp. 2012 and sections 168.011, 168.405, and 168.409, RSMo 2000, the board rescinds a rule as follows:

**5 CSR 20-400.280 Required Assessments for Professional Education Certification in Missouri is rescinded**

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed amendment was published in the Missouri Register on March 1, 2019 (44 MoReg 774). No changes have been made in the text of the proposed rescission, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed rescission becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.
