DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 1:

All Missouri students will graduate college and career ready.

SUMMARY:

During the third and fourth cycles of the Missouri School Improvement Program (MSIP), the Department utilized rule 5 CSR 20-100.180 Waiver of Regulations. This rule established the procedures and criteria for annually identifying school districts and/or school buildings exempt from the MSIP on-site review process and the MSIP Resource and Process Standards not included in the MSIP Items Not Waived Checklist.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed rule was published in the *Missouri Register* on March 1, 2016 (41 MoReg 307-308). No changes have been made in the text of the proposed rule, so it is not reprinted here. The required thirty-day comment period ended on March 31, 2016, and no comments were received.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education authorize publication in the *Missouri Register* of an order of rulemaking to rescind Rule 5 CSR 20-100.180, relating to the Waiver of Regulations, and that the State Board finds this rescission necessary, based on the current version of the Missouri School Improvement Program.
