**DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:**

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

**SUMMARY:**

Stacie A. Scroggins, Respondent, holds two Career Continuous Professional certificates. One in early childhood education for grades PK-3 and another for elementary education grades 1-8, which expire on April 6, 2104.

In February 2007, Respondent pled guilty to one felony count of fraudulent attempt to obtain a controlled substance and received a suspended imposition of sentence for ten (10) days shock detention and two (2) years probation. In May 2010, Respondent pled guilty to one felony count of possession of a controlled substance and was sentenced to three (3) years' incarceration. In May 2011, Respondent pled guilty to one felony count of criminal non-support and received a suspended imposition of sentence and three (3) years probation.

Respondent received notice of the hearing, but was not present and was not represented by counsel.
