      - **Elementary Multi-Content Assessments Test Codes – 007, 008, 009, and 010.**
  - **School Psychologist – K-12**
    - **Drop School Psychologist (057) by Pearson**
    - **Add School Psychologist (5402) by ETS (MQS 147)**

- **32 Points – Task #3 (4 Steps x 4 Points x 2)**
- **64 Points – Total Points Possible**
