 - **School Psychologist – K-12**
 - **Drop School Psychologist (057) by Pearson**
 - **Add School Psychologist (5402) by ETS (MQS 147)**

Standard Setting Activity

- ❑ **Used Standards for Educational and Psychological Testing (AERA, APA, & NCME, 1999 and 2014).**
- ❑ **Engaged panel in a series of activities.**
- ❑ **Used a “Multiple Round, Extended Angoff procedure”**
- ❑ **Obtained item-by-item judgments**
- ❑ **Identified what the “Just Qualified Candidate” would correctly answer**
- ❑ **Standard Setting – Total of Three Rounds**
