What is Consultation?

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- Timely and meaningful
- Discussions
- Genuine opportunity
- Positive and productive working relationships
- ESSA goal: reach “agreement on how to provide equitable and effective programs for eligible nonpublic school children”



Consultation is NOT...

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- A unilateral offer of services by an LEA with no opportunity for discussion.
- Merely sending a letter to nonpublic school officials explaining the intent of Title I.



What does Consultation look like?

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- How to begin?
- When to start?
- Who participates?
- How long does consultation continue?
- Are there consultation requirements?



Consultation Requirements:

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- A. How the children's **needs** will be identified;
- B. What **services** will be offered;
- C. **How, where, and by whom** the services will be provided;
- D. How the services will be academically **assessed** and the results used to improve those services;
- E. The **size and scope** of services to be provided, the proportion of funds allocated and **how that proportion is determined;**



Consultation Requirements...cont'd

- F. The **method or sources of data** used to determine the number of children from low-income families in participating school attendance areas who attend nonpublic schools;
- G. **How and when** the school district will make decisions about the delivery of services;
- H. How, **if the LEA disagrees** with the nonpublic school officials on the provision of services through a contract, the LEA will provide in writing the reasons why it has chosen not to use a contractor;



Consultation Requirements...cont'd

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- I. Whether the LEA shall **provide services directly** or through a separate government agency, consortium, entity, or third-party contractor;
- J. Whether to provide equitable services to eligible nonpublic school children by **combining funds** generated into one or more pools of funds;



Consultation Requirements...cont'd

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- K. **When**, including the approximate time of day, services will be provided; and
- L. Whether to provide services to eligible nonpublic school children by **consolidating** and using funds in coordination with eligible funds available under Title IC, Title IIA, Title IIIA, Title IVA, and Title IVB.



Consultation added to statute

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- If an LEA disagrees with the view of nonpublic school officials regarding any of the issues subject to consultation, it must provide the nonpublic school officials written reasons why it disagrees.
- The results of consultation between the LEA and nonpublic schools must be transmitted to the SEA ombudsman.



Consultation added to statute

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- LEAs must maintain a written affirmation of meaningful consultation, signed by nonpublic school. It must provide the option for nonpublic schools to indicate their belief that timely and meaningful consultation has not occurred or that the program design is not equitable.

Delivery of Instructional Services

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- Who is responsible for planning and designing the Title I program?
- When should Title I services for nonpublic school participants start?
- Where may Title I services take place?



Title I - Neutral Space

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- Definition: A site or space off public school grounds leased by the public school district for the purpose of providing Title I services.
- May be a site or space within the nonpublic school building or other facility on the nonpublic school property subject to certain criteria.
- Consult with the district's private attorney before implementing the neutral space option.



Title I – Neutral Space Criteria

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- Space shall be under the control of the public school district when services are provided or staff is present.
- Control is secured through a lease agreement for specified days and hours.
- Content and all components of the Title I program and services are under control of the public school district, including the assignment of students (public and nonpublic) receiving services at that site.



Title I – Neutral Space Criteria

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- Space may be accessed in a way that minimizes movement through areas having significant religious presence.
- Title I services must comply with the requirements for those services provided in public schools, i.e. secular, neutral and non-ideological.



Services to Nonpublic Schools

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- The Missouri Constitution bars direct and indirect use of public funds to benefit sectarian schools.
 - Funds used only to meet the educational needs of qualifying/participating children
- Public funds may not be sent to the nonpublic school directly from DESE or from the public school district.



Delivery of Equitable Services

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- Considered equitable if the LEA:
 - Spends an equal amount of funds
 - Provides equal services and benefits
 - Addresses and assesses the specific needs and educational progress on a comparable basis
 - Provides equal opportunities to participate in program activities



Delivery of Equitable Services

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- Provides nonpublic school students and their teachers with an opportunity to participate that provides reasonable promise of participating students meeting challenging academic standards.
- Provides different services to the nonpublic school if their needs are different.



Services to Nonpublic Schools

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- Materials, supplies or equipment, paid for with public funds, may not be provided to nonpublic schools for regular program of instruction.
- Programs for nonpublic students, regardless of grade level, must begin at the same time as the programs for public school students.



Services to Nonpublic Schools

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- Allowable
 - Dual enrollment classes
 - Transportation to or from a child's home to the public school
 - Before and after school programs
 - Saturday programs
 - Professional development activities
 - Necessary travel expenses and registrations for PD activities



Dual Enrollment

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- If services are during the regular school day, must dual enroll students
 - Must claim membership and attendance must be in Core Data AND
 - MAP test is not required

If outside of regular school day, then students would not be counted on Core Data



Services to Nonpublic Schools

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- Unallowable
 - Transportation between public and nonpublic schools with instructional funds
 - Materials, supplies, and/or equipment for nonpublic students' regular program of instruction
 - Reimbursement for substitutes for professional development activities



Evaluation

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- Determine:
 - ways to access student outcomes
 - standards
 - how to measure effectiveness
 - what is acceptable annual progress
 - modifications



Allocating Funds

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- Maintain control
- Stipends to nonpublic school teachers
- School by school or pooling



Bypass

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- A means by which the USDOE directly provides equitable services to nonpublic school students and teachers through a third-party provider.
- The USDOE implements bypass IF an SEA or LEA has substantially failed or is unwilling to provide, or is prohibited by law from providing, the required equitable services for nonpublic school children.
- LEAs on bypass are not responsible for providing Title I services to eligible nonpublic school children.

Bypass vs. Third Party Providers

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- Bypass
 - The USDOE contracts for services. Neither the LEA or the SEA are required to monitor these activities and funds do not go through Missouri's Treasury.
- Third Party Provider
 - LEAs may contract with a third party provider. The LEA is responsible to make sure the third party provider follows all requirements of the law.



Third Party Contract Administration

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- LEAs must maintain a contract administration system that ensure contractors perform in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract.
- LEAs must have written contracts which include clearly defined deliverables such as:
 - Description of services
 - Dates when services will be performed
 - Number of students/teachers to be served



Monitoring Requirements

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- Consultation
- Delivery of services
- Participation in activities
- Annual Title I evaluation



Expenditures

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- Proportionate to the number of children from low-income families.
- Proportional share must be determined based on the total amount of funds received by the LEA for Title IA PRIOR to the LEA making any expenditures or transfers of funds.
- Funds must be obligated in the fiscal year for which the funds are received.



Allocation Process for Title IA

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- Improving the Academic Achievement of the Disadvantaged
 - Allocation stays with the LEA in which the child resides.
 - Enrollment and deprivation is collected by the student's resident school district and attendance center.

High Quality PD Criteria

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1. Does the PD activity engage teachers over time?
2. Is the PD directly linked to higher levels of learning so all children may meet the Missouri Learning Standards at the proficient level?
3. Is the PD directly linked to the LEA and CSIP Plans?
4. Is the PD developed with extensive participation of teachers, parents, principals, and other administrators?



High Quality PD Criteria

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5. Does the PD provide time and other resources for learning, practice, and follow-up?
6. Is the PD supported by the LEA and building leadership?
7. Does the PD provide teachers with the opportunity to give the district feedback on the effectiveness of participation in the professional development activity?



Title IIA Nonpublic Allocation Options

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- Option 1 - On a School-By-School Basis: Provide equitable services to nonpublic school students and teachers based on the number of children enrolled in the school.
- Option 2 – Pooling: Combine funds allocated for nonpublic students and teachers for the two or more nonpublic schools interested in participation in this option to create a pool of funds from which the LEA provides equitable services.



1. Using the same measure of low income used to count public school children (Free & Reduced Lunch Count). This count may be collected for funding through School Food Services or collected through a survey form. If enrolled in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program, you must use this method.
2. Using the results of a survey that, to the extent possible, protects the identity of families of private school students, and allowing such survey results to be extrapolated if complete actual data are unavailable. This option allows a school to extrapolate the number of low-income private school children from actual data on a representative sample of private school children. The representative sample size should be large enough to reasonably conclude that the poverty estimate is accurate.
3. Applying the low-income percentage of each participating public school attendance area to the number of private school children who reside in that school attendance area. Using this method will automatically calculate the total number of economically deprived students from each building based on the public school district's percentage of economically deprived students.
4. Using an equated measure of low income correlated with the measure of low income used to count public school children.
