SUMMARY

Applicant's Name: Shareef R. Shabazz

On December 14, 2018, Mr. Shabazz applied for a Missouri substitute certificate of license to teach.

Disposition:

On January 5, 1968, Shareef R. Shabazz (Donald N. Rankin), age 18, was charged with Felony, Assault with Intent to do Great Bodily Harm with Deadly Malice. On April 30, 1968, Mr. Shabazz pled guilty and was sentenced to one year in the workhouse. He was granted a suspended execution of sentence (SES) and was placed on probation for one year. On May 19, 1969, Mr. Shabazz was released from probation after successfully meeting all conditions and requirements for completion.

RECOMMENDATION
