DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:

Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.

SUMMARY:

Tim P. Simpson holds a lifetime certificate of license to teach in the area of Elementary Education, grades 1-8. His certification is current and active.

Educator Certification’s staff assignment report regarding Mr. Simpson indicates that he is not currently employed in a Missouri public school district.

On September 19, 2003, Mr. Simpson pled guilty to the Misdemeanor, Excessive Blood Alcohol Content. Mr. Simpson received a \$500 fine.

On December 22, 2008, Mr. Simpson pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to the Felony, Driving While Intoxicated - Persistent Offender. Mr. Simpson received five (5) years’ supervised probation.

Mr. Simpson received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the State Board of Education revoke Mr. Simpson’s teaching certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2014).
