<p>DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:</p> <p>Missouri will prepare, develop, and support effective educators.</p> <p>SUMMARY:</p> <p>Adam Strauser holds a content substitute certificate. Mr. Strauser's certificate was issued on February 4, 2013, and expired on February 4, 2017.</p> <p>Mr. Strauser is not currently teaching in a Missouri public school.</p> <p>On July 24, 2015, Mr. Strauser pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to two counts of the Felony, Assault – 1st Degree. He was placed on five years of supervised probation. Conditions of his probation include 120 days of shock incarceration and no confrontation with the victims.</p> <p>Mr. Strauser was neither present at the hearing nor was he represented through counsel.</p> <p>PRESENTER:</p> <p>William R. Thornton, General Counsel, will participate in the presentation and discussion of this agenda item.</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION:</p> <p>The Department recommends that the State Board of Education revoke Mr. Strauser's teaching certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (2016).</p>
