All Missouri students will graduate college and career ready.

SUMMARY:

The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education utilized Rule 5 CSR 20-200.130, Relating to Administration, Eligible Contributors, and Tax Credits until these statutes were repealed in 2008 with House Bill 2058. This rule defined eligible administrators and contributors and established guidelines which governed Sponsorship and Mentoring Program tax credits.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the State Board of Education authorize publication in the *Missouri Register* of a notice of proposed rulemaking to rescind Rule 5 CSR 20-200.130, Relating to Administration, Eligible Contributors, and Tax Credits, and that the State Board finds this proposed rescission necessary.

PROPOSED RESCISSION

5 CSR 20-200.130 Administration, Eligible Contributors, and Tax Credits. This rule defined eligible administrators and contributors, and established guidelines which governed Sponsorship and Mentoring Program tax credits.

PURPOSE: This rule is being rescinded as it is no longer necessary as these statutes were repealed in 2008 with House Bill 2058.

AUTHORITY: section 135.348, RSMo Supp. 1998. This rule previously filed as 5 CSR 60-95.020. Original rule filed March 22, 1999, effective Sept. 30, 1999. Moved to 5 CSR 20-200.130, effective Aug. 16, 2011.

PUBLIC COST: This proposed rescission will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

PRIVATE COST: This proposed rescission will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.
