<p>STRATEGIC PRIORITY</p> <p>Teachers and Leaders – Prepare, develop and support educators to ensure an effective teacher in every classroom and an effective leader in every school.</p> <p>SUMMARY</p> <p>Janie L. Tourtillott holds a lifetime certificate of license to teach in the area of Elementary Education, grades 1-8.</p> <p>Ms. Tourtillot was employed as a paraprofessional in the El Dorado Springs R-II School District during the 2016-17 school year.</p> <p>On May 26, 2016, Ms. Tourtillott pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to the Misdemeanor, Driving While Intoxicated, Prior Offender. Ms. Tourtillott was placed on supervised probation for two years. Ms. Tourtillott was ordered to 10 days of shock detention, 240 hours of community service, substance abuse testing, and participation in the Serious Repeat Offender Program.</p> <p>Ms. Tourtillott was neither present at the hearing nor was she represented through counsel.</p> <p>PRESENTER</p> <p>William R. Thornton, General Counsel, will participate in the presentation and discussion of this agenda item.</p> <p>RECOMMENDATION</p> <p>The Department recommends the State Board of Education revoke Ms. Tourtillott’s certificate pursuant to its authority under Mo.
