STRATEGIC PRIORITIES			
Access, Opportunity, Equity – Provide all students access to a broad range of high-quality educational opportunities from early learning into post-high school engagement.			
Teachers and Leaders – Prepare, develop and support educators to ensure an effective teacher in every classroom and an effective leader in every school.			
SUMMARY			
In February 2007, the State Board of Education, pursuant to its authority under Missouri Revised Statute Section 162.1100, adopted a resolution to reestablish the Transitional School District of St. Louis, effective March 15, 2007.			
The continuation of operations of the Transitional School District of St. Louis was authorized in May 2007, November 2010, April 2014 and, again, in February 2016 by the State Board of Education. The authorization is effective until June 30, 2019.			
Section 162.1100 (12) provides that the transitional district shall be terminated by the State Board of Education upon a determination that the transitional district has accomplished the purposes for which it was established and is no longer needed.			
This presentation will provide an update on the current status of the district.
