DEPARTMENT GOAL NO. 3:

SUMMARY:

Ricardo K. Wade holds a lifetime certificate of license to teach in the areas of Health, grades K-12; Physical Education, grades K-12; and Social Studies, grades 7-12.

On December 4, 2000, Mr. Wade pled guilty to one (1) count of the Felony, Driving While Intoxicated-Persistent Offender.

On December 4, 1995, Mr. Wade pled guilty and received a suspended execution of sentence to one (1) count of the Misdemeanor, Driving While Intoxicated. Mr. Wade received two (2) years' of supervised probation.

Mr. Wade received notice of the hearing, but was neither present nor represented by counsel.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the State Board of Education revoke Mr. Wade's teaching certification pursuant to its authority under Mo. Rev. Stat. § 168.071 (Supp. 2014).
