STRATEGIC PRIORITY

Teachers and Leaders – Prepare, develop and support educators to ensure an effective teacher in every classroom and an effective leader in every school.

SUMMARY

Robert Louis Wilson holds a career continuous professional certificate (CPC) of license to teach Spanish, grades K-12. Mr. Wilson is not currently teaching or working as an administrator.

On or about June 29, 2017, Mr. Wilson entered an Alford plea to the Felony, Promotion of Prostitution in the Third Degree. The Court suspended the imposition of Mr. Wilson’s sentence, placed him on probation for five years and ordered the following: 80 hours of alternative community service within six months of sentencing, complete a sex offender assessment and follow any recommendations, and no contact with two identified females.

Mr. Wilson was present at the hearing and was represented by counsel, David F. Barrett.

RECOMMENDATION

The Department recommends the State Board of Education revoke Mr. Wilson’s certificate pursuant to its authority under Section 168.071, RSMo.
