Each year, the department is required to negotiate levels of performance with the United States Department of Education for each of the Perkins Core Indicators of Performance. The following are performance targets for both secondary and postsecondary core indicators of performance for the 2017-18 (FY2018) school year:

2P1 Credential, Certificate or Degree Attainment	46%
3P1 Student Retention or Transfer	66%
4P1 Student Placement	68%
5P1 Nontraditional Participation	27.5%
5P2 Nontraditional Completion	19.5%
