Subject: CCR-21-004 – Missouri Healthy Schools COVID-19 Supplement Survey

The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) are working together to implement the Healthy Schools COVID-19 Supplement survey.
